Bacon dates back at least 3,500 years.

The Chinese were the first to cook salted pork bellies. The salt preserved the meat so it could be eaten all year.

BRINGING HOME THE BACON!

The phrase originated in Great Dunmow, Essex in 1104. When a local couple impressed the Prior of Little Dunmow with their devotion to each other so much that he awarded them a side of bacon. The tradition is still alive today, every four years a couple in the town is awarded.
